Construction of 2(two) Nos. of Raw Water Reservoirs and another 2(two) Nos. of Clear Water Reservoirs for Water Treatment Plant at Doyang Hydro Electric Plant, Doyang, Nagaland.

1. North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Limited, a leading Miniratna Category-I Public Sector Enterprise under the Ministry of Power, Government of India, invites online tender at e-procurement portal <https://etenders.gov.in> under Single-Stage Two-Envelope bidding process through Domestic Competitive Bidding (DCB) route, exclusively from prospective bidders who are Affected Land Owners of Doyang Hydro Electric Plant, Doyang, District Wokha, Nagaland for carrying out the work of "**Construction of 2(two) Nos. of Raw Water Reservoirs and another 2(two) Nos. of Clear Water Reservoirs for Water Treatment Plant at Doyang Hydro Electric Plant, Doyang, Nagaland**" at an estimated cost of ₹ 1,72,87,203.00 (Rupees one crore seventy two lakh eighty seven thousand two hundred and three only).
2. **Bidding Procedure:**
The Bidder shall submit Bids under Single-Stage Two-Envelope bidding system through online as follows:
Techno-Commercial Bid (Envelope No. 1) : Shall contain Bid fee, Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), documents in support of Qualifying Requirements and Techno-Commercial Bid.
Price Bid (Envelope No. 2) : Shall contain Price Bid. Price Bids of only those Bidders who qualify in Techno-Commercial evaluation shall be opened.
3. **Time of Completion:**
The time allowed for completion of the work in all respect is **6(six) months from the date of issue of Letter of Intent (LOI)**.
4. **Earnest Money Deposit:** Earnest Money Deposit shall be ₹ **3,46,000.00 (Rupees three lakh forty six thousand only)**. Earnest Money Deposit may be submitted in the form of Demand Draft or Bank Guarantee as per format provided in Form-C: Tender Forms and Data Sheets, Part-III of the Bid Document or through SB-Collect of State Bank of India. *The bidders registered as Micro/ Small Enterprises are exempted from paying applicable Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), subject to submission of requisite Certificate.*
5. **Scope of work:**
The scope of work includes Construction of 2(two) Nos. of Raw Water Reservoirs and another 2(two) Nos. of Clear Water Reservoirs for Water Treatment Plant at Doyang Hydro Electric Plant, Doyang, Nagaland, as described under Part-V: Technical Specifications, Part-VI: Tender Drawings



and Part-VII: Bill of Quantities, of the Detailed Bid Document, and as per the direction of Engineer-in-Charge.

6. QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS:

6.1 GENERAL QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT FOR THE BIDDER:

Participation in the bidding process is exclusively to bidders who are Affected Land Owners of Doyang Hydro Electric Project, Doyang, District Wokha, Nagaland. The bidders (Individual/ Company/ Firm) shall fulfil either of the following conditions:

- (i) The bidder by itself shall fulfil the Qualifying Requirements mentioned at Clause 6.2 & 6.3 below.
- (ii) If any affected Land Owner of Doyang Hydro Electric Project does not fulfil the Qualifying Requirements mentioned at Clause 6.2 & 6.3 below, he/she may participate in the bid on behalf of any other Individual/ Company/ Firm that fulfils the Qualifying Requirements mentioned at Clause 6.2 & 6.3 below, by virtue of a Power of Attorney granted to the affected Land Owner by such qualified Individual/ Company/ Firm to submit Bid and to act on its behalf.

In such case, all communications and payments shall be done by NEEPCO with such Individual/ Company/ Firm granting the Power of Attorney.

The bidders (Individual/ Company/ Firm) has to compulsorily submit documents in support of being Affected Land Owner duly certified by concerned District Administration along with the Bid.

6.2 TECHNICAL QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT:

- i) The bidders (Individual/ Company/ Firm) should have successfully completed one of the following during the period of 7(seven) years ending on the date in which this NIB is floated.

at least one completed RCC Water Tank or any other Civil work where RCC is a major component valued at ₹ 1.383 Crore or more.

Or,

at least two completed RCC Water Tank or any other Civil work where RCC is a major component each valued at ₹ 86.44 Lakh or more.

Or,

at least three completed RCC Water Tank or any other Civil work where RCC is a major component each valued at ₹ 69.15 Lakh or more.

The bidders shall compulsorily submit along with the Bid, the following authenticated documentary evidence in support of technical qualifying requirement.

- a) Copies of Orders placed on them by Clients/ Owners issued from Government/PSUs.
- b) Certificates of Clients/ Owner issued from Government/PSUs indicating successful Completion of Orders placed on and completed by them, indicating the date of completion of the work(s) and value of completed work.
- c) Bidders having experience in other Civil work where RCC is a major component, the breakup of the RCC component fulfilling the qualifying requirement needs to be submitted along with the bid.

6.3 FINANCIAL QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT:

- i) **Minimum Average Annual Turnover (MAAT):**

Minimum Average Annual Turnover of the bidder shall be ₹ **3.46 Crore** in the best three Financial Year out of the last 5(five) Financial year, ending 31st March of the previous financial year. Other income shall not be considered for arriving at the minimum average annual turnover.

- ii) **Liquid Asset:**

The bidder should have liquid assets or / and evidence to availability of unutilised credit facilities of not less than ₹ **72.03 Lakh**. The Certificate of Banker regarding the availability of unutilised credit facilities (Fund based and non-fund based) shall not be dated earlier than 30(thirty) days prior to the latest date for submission of bids.



Liquid Asset = Current Asset – (Inventory + Pre-paid expenses).

iii) **Net Worth:-**

Net worth of the bidder as on last day of the preceding financial year should not be less than 50% of the Paid up capital.

The Net Worth shall be calculated based on Subscribed and Paid-up Capital + Free Reserves + Unallocated balance surplus amount of Profit and Loss Account less (a) Expenses not written off (b) Loss in Profit & Loss Account if not reduced from Reserves.

iv) **BID CAPACITY:**

The available Bid Capacity of the Bidder at the time of submission of Bid, calculated as under should not be less than the estimated cost of the work put to tender:

Available Bid Capacity = $A \times N \times 2 - B$

Where,

A = Maximum value of works executed in any one year during last 7 (seven) years (at current price level).

N = Completion time of the proposed work in years.

B = Value at current price level of existing commitments and on-going works (as on the latest date for bid submission) to be completed in next "N" years.

Bid capacity shall be assessed at the time of submission of Techno-Commercial Bid, for which the Bidder shall have to submit authentic documentary evidence in support of "A" & "B" above along with their Bid.

Complete Audited Annual Reports along with Audited Balance Sheets, Profit and Loss Account & detailed Schedule and other financial statements for the preceding 5(five) financial years, ending 31st March of the previous Financial Year, along with Letter of adequacy and commitment from their Bankers/ Financial Institutions of International repute should be furnished along with their bids for evaluating the above financial criteria. In case where the audited results of the preceding financial years are not available, certified financial statements from a practising Chartered Accountant will be also considered acceptable.

Authenticated documentary evidence in support of qualifying requirements, as mentioned under Clause 6.1, 6.2 & 6.3 above, shall be submitted in Techno-Commercial Bids. The documents should be in the form of Certificate of Clients/ Owner and from concerned Authorities. Bids submitted without fulfilling the qualifying requirements shall be outright rejected.

7. Interested Bidders, who fulfil the qualifying requirements as mentioned under Clause 6 above, may download the Detailed Bid Document from <https://etenders.gov.in>.

8. Participation in Bids

8.1. Registration for Participation in Bids

- a. Bidders are required to enrol on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link "**Online bidder Enrollment**" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- b. As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- c. Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- d. Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (**Class III Certificates with signing key usage**) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- e. Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
- f. Bidder can then log in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

8.2 Bid Fee:

Bidders shall have to make payment of Bid fee (Non-refundable) of ₹ **2,000.00 plus GST @18%** (indicating **SAC Code 9984 and NEEPCO Shillong GST NO. 17AAACN9991J1ZT**), for participation in this instant NIB. *The bidders registered as Micro/ Small Enterprises are exempted from paying applicable Bid fee, subject to submission of requisite Certificate.*

Procedure for payment of Bid fee:

The bidder shall make the payment through “**SB-Collect**” of **State Bank of India** as per procedures/ steps elaborated as below. The system generated receipt shall also be uploaded while submitting the bid in the e-tendering portal as per bid document.

Payment of Bid fee through other mode of payment like Cheque/ Demand Draft etc. shall not be acceptable. During payment of Bid fee through “SB-Collect” of State Bank of India, bidders shall clearly indicate the NIB No. against which the Bid fee is paid.

Besides online submission, bidders shall also compulsorily submit the original copy of the following documents in offline mode as per Checklist provided in Detailed Bid Document and only the scanned copy shall be uploaded while submitting online bid.

- i) Payment receipt of Bid Fee deposited through SB-Collect of State Bank of India.

9.2 The online bids shall be opened as per the timeline mentioned in Clause 12 below.

10. Reverse Auction:

The tender shall be finalized through "Tender Cum Auction" i.e. through the tender followed by e-Reverse Auction (e-RA). After opening the Financial Bids, Reverse Auction shall be conducted amongst the Techno-Commercially qualified bidders, excluding the Highest (H1) bidder. The date and timing for the Reverse Auction shall be conveyed to the Techno-Commercially qualified bidders. There will be no participation fees for Reverse Auction. The Instruction for Bidders for Reverse Auction is given in Clause 4.5, Part-III, Instruction to Bidders of the Bid Document.

11. **Bid validity:** 180 (one hundred eighty) days from the date of opening of Techno-Commercial Bids.

14. Relaxation of Norms for Startups and Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) on Prior Experience - Prior Turnover Criteria.

In line with the Policy Circular No. 1(2)(1)/2016-MA dated 10th March, 2016 of the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises on "Relaxation of Norms for Startups and Micro & Small Enterprises in Public Procurement on Prior Experience and Prior Turnover Criteria" and as per Section 2.1(5) of "Action Plan for Startup India" announced by the Government of India in Jan 2016, the Criteria of Prior Turnover and Prior Experience are exempted for the Startups and Micro & Small Enterprises, subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications.

Accordingly, Startup/MSE bidders shall be offered exemption from Prior Experience Criteria, provided the bidder submits document such as Startup/MSE registration certificate to prove bidder's registration in trade similar to the tendered job.

Similarly, Startup/MSE bidders shall be offered exemption from Prior Turnover Criteria, provided the bidder submits document such as Startup/MSE registration certificate.

The definition of "Startups" is as per the Gazette Notification of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion) dated 17th February 2016 and all other subsequent directives/guidelines thereof. The Startup Enterprises shall submit startup India recognition certificate issued by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) of Ministry of Commerce & Industry in order to be considered for relaxation in prior experience and prior turn over

15. Conditions for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs):

- 15.1 The bidders participating as Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) shall submit an Undertaking in the prescribed format given under Form-E: Tender Forms & Data Sheets, Part-III of the Bid Document, declaring the status of their firm under the provisions of Micro and Small Enterprises along with a copy of the document/ certificate issued by any of the Authority mentioned below:



- i) District Industries Centers (DICs)
 - ii) Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC)
 - iii) Khadi and Village Industries Board (KVIB)
 - iv) Coir Board
 - v) National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC)
 - vi) Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom
 - vii) MSEs registered under Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum (UAM) w.e.f. 18-09-2015.
 - viii) Any other Body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MoMSME).
- 15.2 The MSEs owned by Scheduled Caste (SC) & Scheduled Tribe (ST) entrepreneurs must submit the SC/ST certificate issued by District Authority in addition to certificate of registration with any one of the agencies mentioned above. The bidder shall furnish necessary documentary evidence to ascertain that the MSE is owned by SC/ST. MSE owned by SC/ST is defined as:
- a) In case of proprietary MSE, proprietor(s) shall be SC /ST.
 - b) In case of partnership MSE, the SC/ST partners shall be holding at least 51% shares in the enterprise.
 - c) In case of Private Limited Companies, at least 51% share shall be held by SC/ST promoters.
- 15.3 The registration certificate submitted by MSEs issued from any one of the above agencies must be valid as on close date of the tender. The successful bidder should ensure that the same is valid till the end of the contract period.
- 15.4 The MSEs who have applied for registration or renewal of registration with any of the above agencies/bodies, but have not obtained the valid certificate as on close date of the tender, are not eligible for exemption/preference.
- 15.5 The MSEs registered with above mentioned agencies/bodies are exempted from payment of BID FEES and EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD). In addition, MSE bidders shall get some other preferences as detailed in Clause 4.8, Part-III, Instruction to Bidders of Bid Document. The Startups bidders are also exempted from payment of EMD. The definition of "Startups" is as per the Gazette Notification of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion) dated 17th February 2016 and all other subsequent directives/guidelines thereof. The Startup Enterprises shall submit startup India recognition certificate issued by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) of Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India.
- 16. Conditions for Class-I local supplier, Class-II local supplier as per Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 issued vide notification No. P-45021/2/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 04-06-2020 of Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Government of India, read in conjunction with Order No. 11/05/2018-Coord. dated 28/07/2020 of Ministry of Power, Government of India shall be as per Clause 4.8, Part-III, Instruction to Bidders of Bid Document.**
17. Submission of bids shall not automatically construe qualification for evaluation. NEEPCO reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to annul the bidding process and reject all the bids for any justified and genuine grounds without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidders, nor does it have any obligation to inform the bidders of the ground for the action of NEEPCO.
